





Bridge Building Challenge 2017 – FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. When we are supposed to build the bridge?

The bridges MUST be made by students themselves PRIOR to the challenge date. It is highly recommended to build the bridge at least 48 hours in advance of the competition date for glue to dry. See the *BBC Rules 2017* document for more details.

2. How can I obtain the bridge building kit?

You can pick up the bridge building kit at the main office of *Tomken Road Middle School* located at *3200 Tomken Rd, Mississauga, ON L4Y 2Y6, Canada*. The school is generally open between 8:30am – 2:20pm but it is advisable to call ahead at 905-277-0321 before picking up the kit. You can only use the popsicle stick (limit 200) and glue inside the kit to make the bridge.

Note: The school is currently closed for March break and will re-open on Monday, March 20th. In the meantime it is recommended to go through the *BBC Rules 2017* and *Judging Criteria 2017* documents to get well versed with the challenge details.

3. What will happen on the day of the challenge?

On the challenge date, students will bring their pre-built bridges for judging in three different areas before it is put in the buster. The buster will break the bridge to determine the strength of the bridge. See the *Judging Criteria 2017* document for more details. Also, see the scheduled *agenda* of the challenge is also attached.

4. How does the registration works?

Students must register at the Eventbrite page. Although one student teams are acceptable, a maximum of two students are allowed in each team. Each team should register once providing their team member(s) name and other details. Registration fee is \$8 per team.

Note: Registration is currently closed.

5. Is there a secret of wining the challenge?
