



RE: Mathletics Challenge Consent Form

Dear Parent/Guardian/Teacher,

The Mathletics Challenge will take place on Saturday, November 7th 2015. This event is organized by the Mississauga Chapter of the Professional Engineers Ontario and is being hosted by the Peel Board of Education. It will be a chance for students to meet with engineers from our local community, to apply their math skills in engineering related problem solving questions.

Students will compete in the challenge as individuals and in teams. There is a \$5.00 registration fee for each student, to be paid on the registration website via www.peo-mc.ca.

The event will take place at the south gym at Tomken Road Middle School. 3200 Tomken Road, in Mississauga between 8:30am and 2:00 pm. Starting at 8:30 am, students will begin the challenge by answering questions projected on the main screen and they will answer using remote control clickers that will register their answers. On this day, student teams MUST be accompanied by one parent or guardian. Your child's teacher may or may not be present, as such, you, or another adult as arranged by your child's team will be supervising the students. Pizza and drinks will be provided for lunch.

Local media will be attending the event. Your child maybe videotaped, photographed and/or interviewed for media stories. Media release: I authorize my child to be videotaped, photographed and/or interviewed for media stories at this event.

I give permission for my child(ren) to participate in the Mathletics Challenge 2015 on Saturday November 7th, 2015. I will arrange for myself, or another adult to accompany and supervise my child at the event. I understand that the Mississauga Chapter of Professional Engineers Ontario and its representatives will take all reasonable steps to provide an environment in which everyone's safety is of prime importance. PEO Mississauga Chapter has arranged the challenge, but PEO Mississauga Chapter cannot take direct care and control of your child. We encourage you to be present at the challenge so that both of you will share and enjoy your child's successes and achievements.
